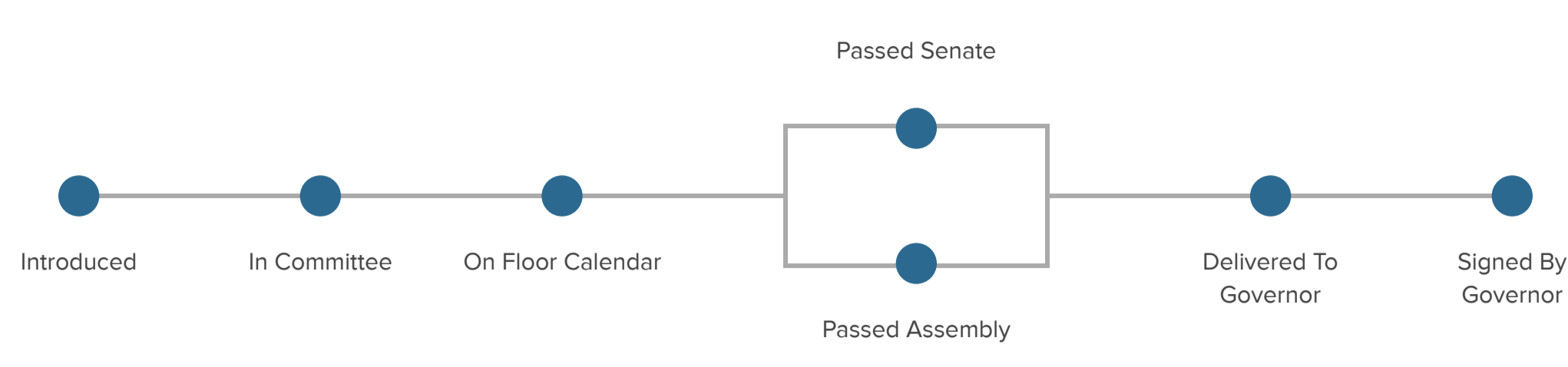

Relates to the uniform treatment of waste from the exploration, development, extraction, or production of crude oil or natural gas.

S3392 (ACTIVE) - SPONSOR MEMO

TITLE OF BILL: An act to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the uniform treatment of waste

PURPOSE:

This bill would require hazardous wastes produced from oil and natural gas activities to be subject to the requirements for treatment of hazardous wastes.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS:

The bill adds a new subdivision 4 to section 27-0903 of the Environmental Conservation Law that would classify all waste resulting from oil or natural gas production activities as hazardous waste, if such waste meets the definition of hazardous wastes set forth in the Environmental Conservation Law. This section also directs the Department of Environmental Conservation to make all necessary changes to bring its rules and regulations into compliance with this section.

AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the uniform treatment of waste
THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1. Section 27-0903 of the environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:
4. UNIFORM TREATMENT OF WASTE. ALL WASTE RESULTING FROM THE EXPLORATION, DEVELOPMENT, EXTRACTION OR PRODUCTION OF CRUDE OIL OR NATURAL GAS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO DRILLING FLUIDS AND PRODUCED WATERS, SHALL BE CONSIDERED HAZARDOUS WASTE UNDER THE LAW OF THIS STATE AND SUBJECT TO ALL PERTINENT GENERATION, TRANSPORTATION, TREATMENT, STORAGE, AND DISPOSAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS, IF SUCH WASTE MEETS THE DEFINITION OF HAZARDOUS WASTE SET FORTH IN SUBDIVISION THREE OF SECTION 27-0901 OF THIS CHAPTER. WITHIN SIX MONTHS FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBDIVISION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE ALL NECESSARY CHANGES TO BRING ITS REGULATIONS INTO COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
