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Thank you Daniel, appreciate the clarification.

With regard to the requested topsoil inventory, the site is located within an active agricultural facility with substantial topsoil and subsoil materials available. A screening berm located on the property along Rt 409 contains at least 2,750 cubic yards of soil materials that would be available to the operator at reclamation. That quantity is in excess of twice the amount needed to reclaim the life-of-mine affected area of 14.33 acres with at least 6 inches of soils capable of supporting vegetation. Topsoil materials located within the current life-of-mine boundary are more limited however; several yards of material are located in containment berms adjacent to the existing lined ponds and the scale house/shop area. We estimate approximately 350 cubic yards of material is available from these berms located within the current life-of-mine area.

The organizational report form provided with the submittal and already on-file with DEC includes the current organizational information; please clarify if a newly completed organizational report form is being requested/required.

Also, while we will certainly provide the requested soil inventory and understand its importance in determining bonding amounts, it is our understanding that per the New York State Mined Land Reclamation Law and NYSDEC mining regulations, required components of a renewal application for purposes of SAPA protection are limited to:

(1) completed application forms;

(2) an updated mining plan map consistent with the provisions of title 27 and including an

identification of the area to be mined during the proposed permit term;

(3) a description of any changes to the mined land-use plan; and
